This book contains many speech bubbles. It would be good to remind children that speech bubbles show what somebody is saying.

Words that may need help:

- *he's*
- *she's*
- *mouse* - the 'se' makes just a 's' sound
- *comes*

Yellow - Dance to the Beat

Hopefully you have been managing to keep active during lockdown. After reading why not use the actions on p14/15 to make up your own dance?

Words that may need help:

- *dance* - the 'ce' at the end makes a 's' sound
- *you*
- *listen* - silent 't'
- *music* - the 'u' is the long 'ew' sound
- *your*

Blue - Arctic Life

This book is an information book about the Arctic. There is a contents page you may wish to use to select pages to read. This book does not need to be read in order.

- *Arctic* - the middle 'c' is silent
- *Earth* - the 'ear' is said 'ur'
- *world* - the 'or' is also said as 'ur'
- *do*
- *people*
- *live* - silent 'e'
- *all*
- *wear* - the 'ear' is pronounced 'air'
- *have*
- *their/there*
- *other* - the 'o' is pronounced 'u'
- *built* - the 'u' isn't pronounced
- *through*
- *hares* - the 'are' sounds as 'air'
- *by*
- *warmer* - the 'ar' is said as an 'or'

Green - Seahorses

This book shares interesting facts about seahorses and their life.

Words that may need help:

- *special* - the ending is tricky
- *seahorse* - the 'se' just sounds as an 's'
- *their*
- *forwards* - the 'ar' sounds a little like an 'u' (regional dialect)
- *centimetres/millimetres*

- *they're*
- *stomach* - uses the alternative 'ch' sounding as a 'c'
- *store/shore* - both have a silent 'e'
- *people*
- *straight*

Orange - Morris Plays Hide and Seek

Words that may need help:

- *biscuits* - the 'u' is silent
