<u>How to make a wormery</u>



You will need:

Newspaper	sand	leaves
Garden soil	water	Vegetable peelings
Large plastic bottle	compost	Sellotape
card (cut up a cereal box)	Scissors	A few worms! tape

Step 1



ask a grown up to help you cut the top off the plastic bottle and make small holes in

the bottom.

<u>Step 2</u>



Add layers of sand, compost and soil. Pour in a little water to dampen. Carefully place some worms then scatter leaves and vegetable peelings on the top.

Step 3



cut out a circle from some card and tape it to the top of the bottle. Keep your

bottle in a cool dark place for a about a week. Then take a look. What has happened to the vegetable peelings? Have the worms made any patterns?
