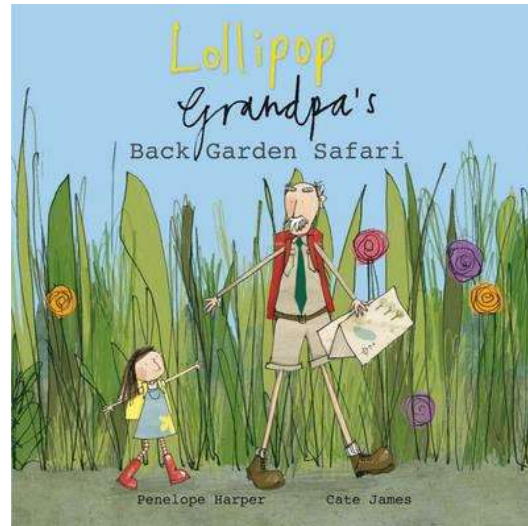


Lollipop and Grandpa's back garden safari

- Find out about a real safari.
What animals would you see? Which is your favourite? Could you create a fact file about one?
