

**Red level readers-**

**Book Title- My Exercise Diary** This is a non-fiction book about a boy who keeps a diary of all the exercise he completes in 1week. This book links with our get moving star challenges. As usual share the front cover etc and discuss.

Questions you might ask-

What is the book about? Do you think we will be using our imagination? What do you think we will be finding out about? What is a diary?

Share the text, stopping to discuss and ask questions about the illustrations on each page.

Take time to reinforce the day of the week. Ask what day will be next if its Monday on this page?

Share the book to the end.



Talk through the activities the boy did and in what order. Can your child


add a simple sentence to go with each picture? Can they keep a diary of their daily exercise, using pictures/sentences?

## Yellow book level-




Book title- Rolling outside.

Share and discuss the features of the front cover. What are the children doing? Do they look happy or sad and why?

Share the story looking and discussing the illustrations as you go.

On the final page, take time to look in more detail at the picture. What can they see happening in the distance? What is the girl in the yellow coat doing?
