Learning Point: The Magic Seed.

Imagine you are like Jack, in Jack and the Beanstalk and you have a magic seed. What does it grow into? What sort of plant is it? Write a story about your adventures with The Magic Seed.

Maths Task



Learning Point: Measuring

Just like Jim from 'Jim and the Beanstalk', you've got to find out all of the measurements for the people at home. Measure heads, feet, hands, legs. Draw your own table and look at who has the longest legs or who has the biggest head. What else can you measure? Practice with using centimetres (cm).



Science Task

Learning Point: What a plant needs to grow well.

On a windowsill grow two seeds, any seeds. When the seeds have started to grow change ONE thing about one of them, whether one gets less water, or you put it to grow in a cupboard. Which one does better? The one that stayed the same or the one that had a change made to it?

ART

Learning Point: Petals and Leaves Collage Picture

Create a 'natural' picture, collect leaves, petals, small twigs, lots of natural materials to create a picture of a garden scene. Use PVA glue to stick everything down and put a layer of cling film or a plastic wallet over it to keep things from falling off. (TIP: If you press the flowers between the pages of a heavy book and some kitchen paper, they will dry out and last longer.)

Learning Point: To design a mini world.

Use a coffee lid or plastic vegetable tray to create your own mini world...

Or decorate a clay plant pot for your own bulbs to grow in, or find some smooth pebbles to paint designs onto.
